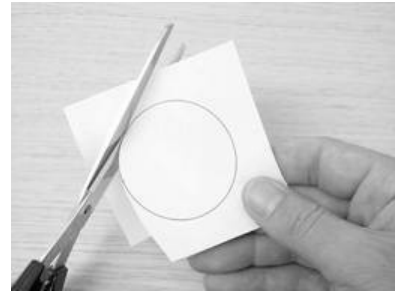

If you have purchased one of our best-selling products, here are some tips on how to get the best from them and lose that awkward style we all develop through trying to make right-handed versions work!

## Left-Handed Scissors

If you have bought these—congratulations. You probably know how rare truly left-handed scissors are, as they must have the blades reversed as well as the grips comfortably moulded, which few manufacturer do.

When you first cut with your scissors, relax your hand more than you are used to, as you no longer need to squeeze the blades together. This also means you don't need to push your thumb knuckle hard against the handgrips either as no force need be exerted. Now try cutting along a line. You will notice that the blade doesn't obscure the line you are trying to cut, so you can cut *exactly* on the line. Do make sure you keep the scissor blade exactly upright to the paper though, with the paper straight, and cut the circle out in a clockwise direction, starting from the left side. (We often cut "back to front" and bend the scissors so we can peer over the blades on right-handed scissors. Now you don't have to!)



## Peelers

Two obvious benefits here—no more scraped knuckles, and no messy peelings all over the kitchen sink! You are probably used to pushing the peeler away from your body, if you have used a right-bladed peeler in the past.



A far more comfortable and controlled way is to place your thumb on the piece of fruit or vegetable and draw the peeler towards your thumb, moving your thumb back further each time you peel towards it. Easy! The challenge is to keep the apple peel in one continuous loop! (Selected models: Blade on back is for removing blemishes).

## Can Openers

Old habits die hard, so remember this opener goes on the LEFT side of the can, where you position the cutting cog in the lip of the tin, squeeze the handles together with your RIGHT hand till the cog pierces the tin, then push the turning handle away from you using your LEFT thumb—easy, effortless and no more spills!



## Fountain Pens

If you hated using standard fountain pens at school, with all the scratching and smudging that entailed, we are sure you will be delighted with your new, specially designed, left-handed fountain pen, and hope you find it a real pleasure to write with. The pen you have chosen has one of two nib designs —either the **ball tip nib** that is machined to give smooth ink flow writing left-handed from almost any angle, or the **oblique nib**, ideal for italic writing and sometimes preferred by writers with the “hooked” handwriting position.

By far the best position for the hand to be in is underneath the writing line, preventing smudging and bad posture. 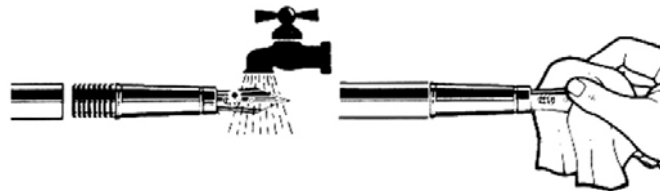
All our pens are supplied with one ink cartridge placed upside down in the barrel (you will need to turn it round to start using it). If you have any trouble getting the ink flow started when you first use your pen, dip the end of the nib into water to help pull the ink through. All our pens are compatible with our Pelikano Cartridges or Universal Cartridges available from all good stationers.

### Refilling with ink cartridges

Insert two cartridges into the barrel making the two ends meet and screw barrel tightly (see diagram)



Your left-handed fountain pen is a specialised item and should be treated with care. We recommend that you occasionally wash out the pen nib with water to keep a smooth ink flow. The barrel can be cleaned by wiping gently with a soft damp cloth.



## Pencil Sharpeners

Keep your pencil where it belongs.... In your *left* hand and hold the sharpener in your right. With your left-handed sharpener, you turn the pencil away from you (anti-clockwise) so the shavings fall away from you and not in your lap!



## Knives

Using your left-hand serrated knife for the first time may be a real eye opener, since we rarely blame the knife because we cannot cut straight! A knife that has the serrations on the left side of the blade does not work well for left-handers, as the serrations exaggerate the natural twisting motion of the left hand, rather than correct it — hence the overhanging loaf! The same principle applies to all kitchen or dinner knives which are serrated on the left. All our knives are serrated on the right side to give a straight cut when used in the left hand.



## Corkscrews

All corkscrews are based on the concept that it is easier to push and turn away from your body than in towards it—as you will now discover with your left-handed version! The difference here is that the screw thread is reversed, so you hold it in your left hand and turn anti-clockwise as you push down into the cork. This takes much less effort and gives more control.

No more having to hold a right-handed corkscrew still while you turn the whole bottle to make it work! Cheers!

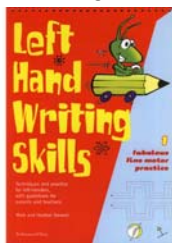
